There was a Declaration of the Election by Acclamation made for Laurae McNally for the position of School Trustee. As the successful candidate, Laurae McNally will serve a three year term, commencing from December 2008 and terminating December 2011, in this position.

GENERAL VOTING DAY will be open to qualified electors of the Corporation of the City of White Rock on Saturday, November 15, 2008 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. at any of the following locations:

**Star of the Sea Centre – 15262 Pacific Avenue;
Centennial Arena – 14600 North Bluff Road;
St. John’s Presbyterian Church – 1480 George Street;
Kent St. Activity Centre – 1475 Kent Street; and
White Rock Museum – 14970 Marine Drive.**

Electors Registration

If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place. To register you must meet the following qualifications:

- 18 years of age or older
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding voting day
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in the Corporation of the City of White Rock for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day, and
- not otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

In order to **register** (this is only necessary if you are not already on the voters list) to vote you will also be required to produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors must produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, proof that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if applicable, written consent from the other property owners.

Advance Voting Opportunities

New legislation now permits all eligible voters to utilize an advance voting opportunity should they choose to do so; previously a solemn declaration was necessary noting that the voter met specific criteria.

Advance voting will be open at the **Star of the Sea Centre located at 15262 Pacific Avenue, White Rock, BC** on Wednesday, November 5, 2008, Thursday, November 6, 2008 and Wednesday November 12, 2008 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. each day.

Special Voting Opportunity

A special voting opportunity (mobile voting) will be held at Oceanview Care Home (8:45 a.m. – 10:45 a.m.) 15628 Buena Vista Avenue, Evergreen Baptist Home (12:30 p.m. – 1:45 p.m.), 1550 Oxford Street, and Peace Arch District Hospital (3:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.), 15521 Russell Avenue on Thursday, November 13, 2008. Only those qualified electors who are admitted patients or registered residents of the extended care institution(s) and/or hospital(s) or employees of the extended care institution(s) and/or hospital(s) at the time of voting may vote at this special voting opportunity.

Mail Ballot Opportunity

New this election the City of White Rock will be conducting Mail In Ballots for persons who have a physical disability, illness or injury that affects their ability to vote at another voting opportunity, and for persons who expect to be absent from the City on general voting day and at the times of all advance voting opportunities. Electors voting by mail ballot must sign a statement indicating that they qualify to vote by mail ballot. Those electors who are eligible and wish to vote by mail ballot may make an application to the Chief Election Officer up until 4:00 p.m. on November 13, 2008.

NOTE: It is the obligation of the person applying to vote by mail ballot to ensure that the mail ballot is received by the Chief Election Officer before 8:00 p.m. Saturday, November 15, 2008.
