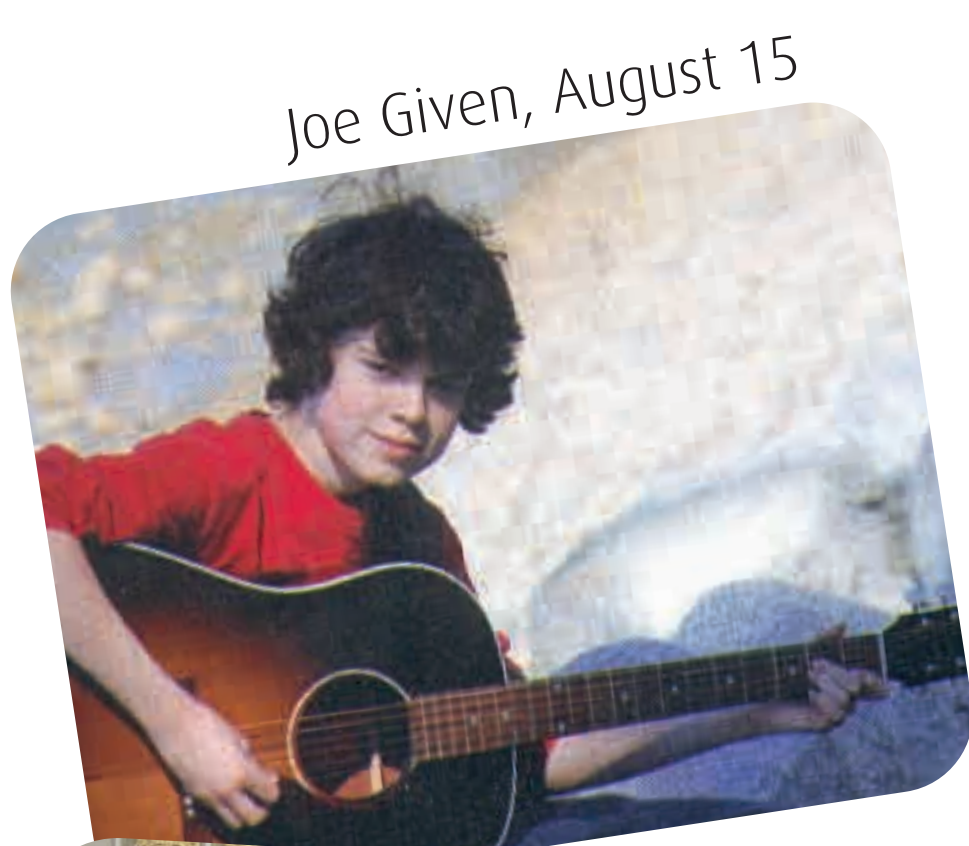
16 Sunday **Pacific Showtime Chorus**
