Safely Caring for Your Tree:

- Set your tree in its stand as soon as possible or store it in a sheltered, unheated area to keep it from drying out.
- Cut 1 – 2 cm off the bottom of your tree before placing it in the stand; the stand should hold a minimum 4L of water.
- Keep your tree away from heat sources, including radiators, heat vents, fireplaces, stoves and TVs.
- Don't use lights with cracked cords or empty sockets.
- Use CSA-approved mini- or LED-lights. They produce little heat and are energy efficient.
- Never use candles or outdoor light sets.
- Turn tree lights off when no one is in the room.
- Water daily. On average, trees absorb 4L of water the first day and then 1L per day thereafter.
- If the tree runs out of water for more than 2 hours, dried sap will prevent the tree from absorbing water. Make a fresh cut off the bottom and refill the stand.
