Park & Ride to the Seaside makes White Rock beaches easier to reach!

People planning to hit the beach in White Rock this summer will have an easier time getting there thanks to enhanced service on the **C52 Seaside / White Rock Centre**. Beginning **July 4** and running through Labour Day, this Community Shuttle will run every 15 minutes, rather than every half-hour, on **weekends and holidays between 1 – 8 pm**.

“People love coming to our beach,” says White Rock Mayor Catherine Ferguson, “but parking can be scarce and visitors can spend a lot of time circling the area, looking for a spot. This increased weekend shuttle service will make it more convenient for people to park in the Town Centre area and then spend their time doing what they came to do—enjoying themselves on the beach. Our seaside businesses can also look forward to more potential customers.”

Ferguson notes that there are a variety of places to park in the Town Centre area, including in the underground lot at the new White Rock Community Centre (15154 Russell Avenue).

The increased service will mean as many as 200 people can be taken to and from the beach each hour – twice as many as at present. After 8pm, service goes to once every half hour, with the last bus leaving Marine Drive & Martin at 11:32 pm on Saturdays and 9:32 pm on Sundays and holidays.

The increased service is part of a number of seasonal enhancements on bus routes around Metro Vancouver, to help residents and visitors get to beaches, Stanley Park and other popular summer-time destinations.
