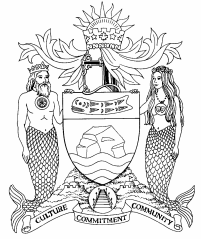

City awaits court ruling

White Rock—The City of White Rock is not taking any position on the merits of a petition filed by former Councillor Matt Todd with the B.C. Supreme Court.

The petition, filed on December 19, 2008, alleges Councillor James Coleridge's re-election November 15 contravenes the Local Government Act.

"The City is named on the petition because the election was held in the City of White Rock, however the City is not being accused of any wrongdoing in the conduct of the election," said Mayor Catherine Ferguson. "This is a matter between former Councillor Todd and Councillor Coleridge, and we're awaiting a decision from the Court along with everyone else."

A hearing, originally set for January 7, is now scheduled to be heard February 9-12.
