Yard waste will be collected as scheduled on Monday, November 9 for residents who would normally have collection on this day.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the City of White Rock will hold a Public Meeting in the City Hall COUNCIL CHAMBERS, 15322 Buena Vista Avenue, White Rock, BC, on **MONDAY, NOVEMBER 16, 2009 at 7:00 p.m.** to consider proposed Development Variance Permits 307 and 308. At this Public Meeting, all persons who believe their interest in the properties is affected by the proposed Development Variance Permit applications shall be afforded an opportunity to be heard or to present written submissions respecting matters contained in the following applications that are the subject of the Public Meeting.

1) DEVELOPMENT PERMIT NO. 307

APPLICANT: Tarlochan Bath

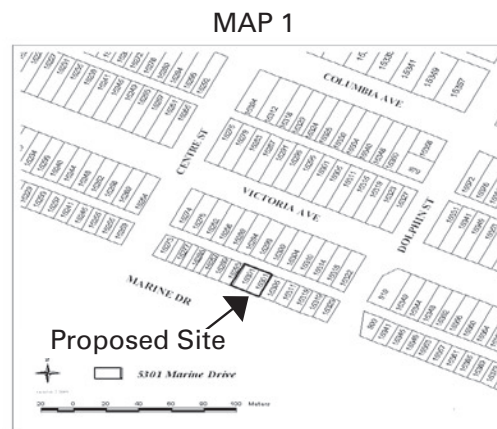
CIVIC ADDRESS: 15301 Marine Drive

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Development Variance Permit No. 307 (DVP 307) is to vary Section 503 of Zoning Bylaw 1999, No. 1591 to allow the construction of an accessory building (garage/carport) by enclosing an existing retaining wall structure with a roof deck and garage doors. Specifically, DVP 307 will:

1. Vary Section 503(b)(ii) to increase the permitted gross floor area for accessory buildings from 6.0 m² (64.5 ft²) to 69.76 m²(750 ft²);
2. Vary Section 503 (b) (iii) to permit an accessory building in front of the principle building with a 0.0 m front yard setback; and
3. Vary Section 503 (b) (iv) (2) to reduce the interior side yard requirement for an accessory building from 1.2 m (3.94 ft) to 0.0 m (0 ft).



DVP 307 will require the applicant to consolidate the two current lots into one and to remove a shed encroaching on the City laneway at the rear of the property.

2) DEVELOPMENT PERMIT NO. 308

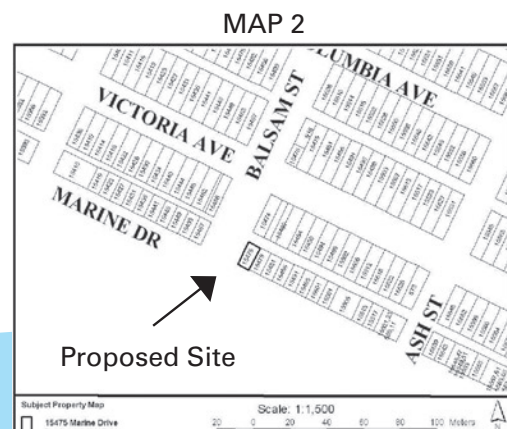
APPLICANT: Victor Dawydiak

CIVIC ADDRESS: 15475 Marine Drive

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Development Variance Permit No. 308 is to vary Zoning Bylaw Sec 402.2(c) to reduce the number of required off street parking spaces to zero (0) from four (4) for a new restaurant located at 15475 Marine Drive. Patrons of the restaurant will be required to use the City's pay parking areas.



Copies of the proposed Development Variance Permits and reports may be inspected in the Planning & Development Services Office at White Rock City Hall, 15322 Buena Vista Avenue, White Rock B.C. from Monday November 2, 2009 to Monday November 16, 2009 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 a.m. excluding weekends and statutory holidays.
