Notice of Tax Sale

NOTICE is hereby given that the following properties will be offered for sale by public auction at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, September 28, 2009 in the Council Chambers at the City Hall, 15322 Buena Vista Avenue, White Rock, B.C. unless the delinquent taxes thereon are previously paid.

Purchasers of tax sale properties should be aware that they will not have the right to receive title or possession until after a period of one year has elapsed following the date of sale. During the one year period, the registered owner of the property or the owner of a registered charge may redeem the property thus canceling the sale. In that event, the purchaser would be entitled to receive a refund of the amount paid together with interest to the date of redemption as provided in Sec. 417 of the Local Government Act.

Council Procedure

In July 2009 City Council adopted a new Council Procedure Bylaw No. 1860. Under the Bylaw, "Question Period" will occur at the start of each regular council meeting, rather than the end.

Please note that Question Period...

- i) will be timed;
- ii) will not exceed 15 minutes; and
- iii) will not be extended by Council.

Here is a summary of the other rules regarding Question Period:

A citizen will be allowed one opportunity to speak and will have up to two (2) minutes maximum to do so. The Presiding Member will then request the next person wishing to speak to come forward, or seeing none will close the Question Period.

Questions to any one member of Council will be ruled out of order.

Once a question has been asked, the Presiding Member will either reply or direct the question to a member of Council or the City Manager (who may reply or request a staff person to reply).

Questions that cannot be answered that evening will be referred to staff for written response or report at the earliest opportunity. Written responses will be copied into a following agenda package so all are aware of the answer to the question.

The following types of questions will not be permitted:

- matters on which the City has commenced prosecution and on which judgment has not been rendered; and
- a matter that is the subject of a public hearing.

Minutes will not be taken during Question Period, however, questions on items requiring written response or report will be noted.
