It's that time of year again. Courtesy Parking Decals are now available for sale at White Rock City Hall, Centennial Park Leisure Centre and Kent Street Activity Centre. The cost will be \$26.25 (\$25.00 plus GST).

City Hall is open Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Centennial Park Leisure Services is open Monday to Thursday, 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Fridays, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and Saturdays, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

For your convenience, the following extended customer service hours are available at City Hall:

8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Monday, February 23
8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Saturday, February 28
9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Garbage Decals and Dog Licences will also be available for purchase during these times.

To qualify for a Courtesy Parking Decal, you must:

- Be a resident of the City of White Rock
- Produce a valid driver's licence bearing your White Rock address
- Produce your current valid owner's certificate of insurance (ICBC) and vehicle licence showing the same address as your driver's licence.

Are you a veteran? Parking is free on the waterfront and at all City of White Rock parking meters for all vehicles bearing Veteran Licence Plates—no courtesy decal required!

Tree Maintenance

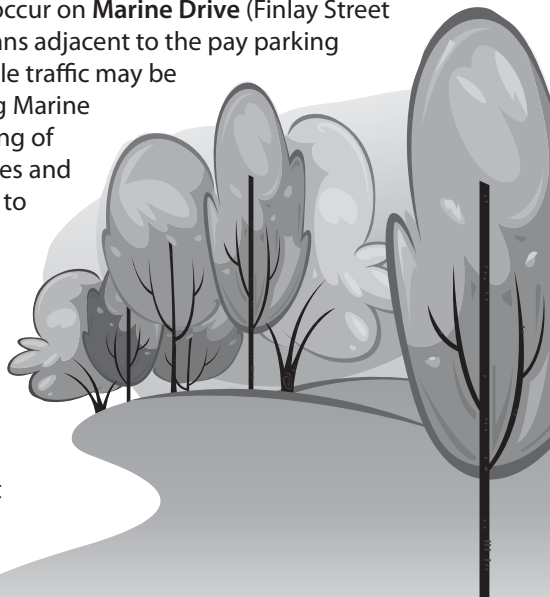
The City of White Rock will be undertaking tree maintenance next week on **Johnston Road** north of Thrift Avenue.

All trees in this area will have their crowns cleared of dead, diseased and damaged limbs. Additional maintenance will include the removal of unsound growth and the lifting of crowns where it is necessary to accommodate traffic, parking, utilities, awnings and buildings. To ensure safety, parking stalls and sidewalks may be closed while work is being done; however, every effort will be made to minimize any interruption.

Tree maintenance will also occur on **Marine Drive** (Finlay Street to Totem Park) on the medians adjacent to the pay parking lots. Parking stalls and vehicle traffic may be affected. Maintenance along Marine Drive will include the cleaning of crowns, the lifting of canopies and the removal of obstructions to utilities.

Please note that the City will not be topping any trees in either of these areas.
