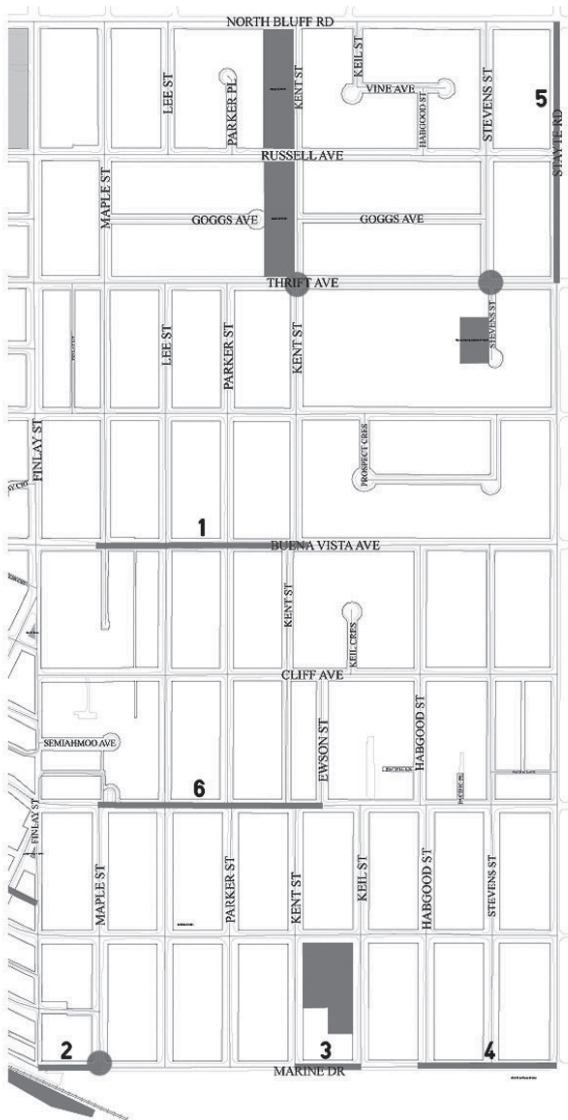

Public Notice is given to the electors of the Corporation of the City of White Rock that nominations for the office of:

Councillor – One (1)

for the balance of the December 2008, to December 2011 term, will be received by the Chief Election Officer or a designated person at City Hall located at 15322 Buena Vista Avenue, White Rock, BC from **9:00 a.m. Tuesday, July 28, 2009 until 4:00 p.m. Friday, August 7, 2009** (excluding statutory holidays and weekends).

Nomination documents are available at the Corporation of the City of White Rock, City Hall, 15322 Buena Vista Avenue during regular office hours.

Qualifications for Office

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- not disqualified by the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or from being nominated for, being elected to, or holding office.

Advance Elector Registration

Are you eligible to vote at the September 12, 2009 By-Election to elect one (1) councillor for the Corporation of the City of White Rock? Is your name on the current list of electors?

If you are not sure you can find out by calling 604.541.2129 or 604.541.2212 or visiting the Corporation of the City of White Rock at 15322 Buena Vista Avenue, White Rock, BC. The office is open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday (excluding holidays).

Advance elector registrations will be accepted at the Corporation of the City of White Rock office until July 21, 2009. With the exception of registrations on voting days, elector registrations will not be accepted during the period July 22, 2009 – September 11, 2009.

Elector Qualifications

RESIDENT ELECTORS:

- age 18 or older; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration; and
- a resident of the Corporation of the City of White Rock for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration; and
- not disqualified by any enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS:

- age 18 or older; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration; and
- a registered owner of real property in the Corporation of the City of White Rock for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration; and
- not entitled to register as a resident elector; and
- not disqualified by any enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law; and
- **if there is more than one registered owner of the property, only one of those individuals may, with the written consent of the majority of the owners, register as a non-resident property elector.**

List of Registered Electors

Beginning July 28, 2009 until the close of general voting for the by-election on September 12, 2009, a copy of the list of registered electors will, upon signature, be available for public inspection, at the Corporation of the City of White Rock office at 15322 Buena Vista Avenue, White Rock, BC, during regular office hours, Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays. An elector may request that their address or other information about them be omitted from or obscured on the list of electors.

Objection to Registration of an Elector

An objection to the registration of a person whose name appears on the list of registered electors may be made in accordance with the Local Government Act until 4:00 pm on August 7, 2009. An objection must be in writing and may only be made by a person entitled to be registered as an elector of the Corporation of the City of White Rock and can only be made on the basis that the person whose name appears has died or is not qualified to be registered as an elector of the Corporation of the City of White Rock.
