

Holiday Collection Schedule

White Rock City Hall will be closed on Monday, October 12, 2009 for Thanksgiving. Recycling, garbage and yard waste collection will be scheduled as follows:



Garbage and Recycling – Single-Family Homes/Duplexes
Service not affected by the holiday.

Garbage and Recycling – Multi-Family Homes/Commercial Bins

Multi-family and commercial properties with overhead bin collection normally falling on Monday, October 12, will have their garbage/recycling collected on Tuesday, October 13. All other collection days remain unchanged.

Yard Waste

Properties with yard waste collection scheduled for the week of October 12 will have their collection on Tuesday, October 13.

Please have all garbage, recycling and yard waste receptacles curbside before 8:00 a.m. on your collection day. There is a 10-unit (bag/container/bundle) limit on yard waste collection for all properties.
