

## Holiday Collection Schedule

The City of White Rock Municipal Hall will be closed on Monday, August 3 for BC Day.

Garbage, recycling and yard waste collection will be scheduled as follows:

### Single-Family Homes/Duplexes

If you live in a single-family home or duplex and your yard waste schedule falls on Monday, August 3, your yard waste will be collected on Tuesday, August 4. Please note that there is a 10-bag limit on curbside yard waste collection. Regular garbage/recycling collections are not impacted by the holiday.

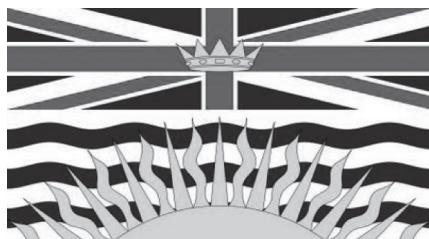
### Multi-Family Homes/Commercial Bins

If you live in a multi-family home or are a commercial property with overhead bin collection and your garbage/recycling schedule falls on Monday, August 3, your garbage/recycling will be collected on Tuesday, August 4. Those multi-family and commercial properties with scheduled yard waste collection for the holiday week are advised that their collection will take place on Tuesday, August 4. Please note that there is a 10-bag limit (every 2 weeks) on this user-call service.

**Please have all garbage, recycling and yard waste receptacles curbside before 8:00am on your collection day.**

## Take the Bus to the Beach

### More C52 improvements

Planning to go to the beach? It's easier than ever to take the bus.

Beginning **August 1** and running through Labour Day, the **C52 Seaside / White Rock Centre Community Shuttle** will run **every 15 minutes, seven days a week** (1:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.), including weekends and holidays.

Park for free in the Town Centre area, and avoid the hassle of circling the waterfront lots looking for a spot.

The increased service will mean as many as 200 people can be taken to and from the beach each hour – twice as many as at present. After 8 p.m., service goes to once every half hour, with the last bus leaving Marine Drive & Martin at 11:32 p.m. on Saturdays and 9:32 p.m. on Sundays and holidays. ### Tree Replacement

At the City of White Rock, we know how important trees are to a neighbourhood—whether they're located on private or public property.

While the Parks Division endeavours to preserve trees on City property whenever possible, unfortunately there are times when a tree poses a hazard due to damage, disease or decay and must be removed.

Please note that 17 cherry trees on Roper Avenue (adjacent to White Rock Elementary School) have been inspected by a certified member of the International Society of Arboriculture and will be removed in the next few weeks due to disease.

The good news? The City has received funding as part of the Trees for Tomorrow program to have community volunteers plant 30 new trees along the sidewalk north of the school.
