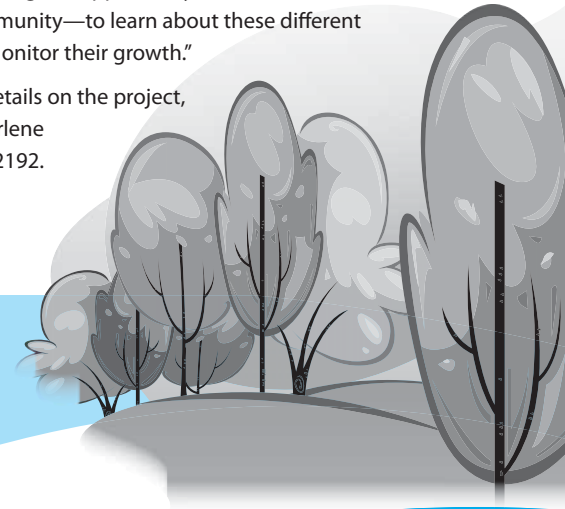
Trees for Tomorrow Planting Day at White Rock Elementary School

"We're going to be replacing them with different smaller scale cultivars. It's a great opportunity for the kids—and the whole community—to learn about these different trees and monitor their growth."
